

International Order of the Rainbow for Girls Pennsylvania Grand Assembly 2020 Poster Competition Rules

To allow **all** assemblies a chance to participate in a competition at Grand Assembly there is a poster competition. This competition offers everyone a chance to use their art or scrapbooking skills to present the story of their assembly from one Grand Assembly to the next. Using pictures, newspaper clippings, art or any other publicity items or mementos related to events important to your assembly throughout the year, each assembly can create a poster board for competition. More importantly this poster board can then be used in your home community to promote the assembly at any events where Rainbow may appear.

The following is a list of rules and regulations for the 2020 Poster Competition:

1. All posters must bear the name and number of the assembly. Also somewhere on the poster there must be a line stating "Sponsored by" with the name of the group that sponsors the assembly.
2. The size of the poster can not exceed the size of a standard three panel display board that can be purchased at office supply or craft stores. The overall size must be no higher than 36" tall or wider than 48". A material other than cardboard or foam core can be used, but the dimensions must be within the guidelines.
3. Included on the poster must be the official International Order of the Rainbow for Girls logo. It should be at least 2 1/2" inches in width. The standard Rainbow patch may be attached to the poster board to fulfill this requirement or a copy of the logo may be printed and attached.
4. The poster can include programs (Installations, official events, or dinners), pictures, printed material, newspaper clippings, or anything of importance that shows the activities of your assembly between Grand Assembly 2019 and Grand Assembly 2020. Qualities to keep in mind: originality, neatness, continuity, and creativity.
5. Items on your poster may not extend more than 1/2" from the surface. Push pins or thumb tacks may not be used to attach items to the board.
6. Suggestions for good posters include: Plan before starting so special events are included, date and label printed material, be neat in pasting and clipping. Include pictures that depict Rainbow, and items of interest from events. Add captions and labels so your poster tells a story about Rainbow and your assembly. Include artistic personal touches to tell that story. Avoid material irrelevant to Rainbow. All items must be permanently attached to the poster board. Be creative and have fun. Let your assembly's personality show. Posters are great recruiting tools for new members!
7. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope attached to the back of the poster when delivering your poster to the Grand Assembly judging area. A copy of the poster scoring sheet will be sent to the Mother Advisor or assembly representative after Grand Assembly.
8. PLEASE REMEMBER THIS COMPETITION IS FOR THE GIRLS ONLY, THERE IS TO BE NO ADULT HELP ON THE POSTER CONTENTS. IF SOME TYPE OF REUSABLE WOODEN OR PERMANENT POSTER DISPLAY IS CONSTRUCTED THIS MAY BE BUILT BY AN ADULT, BECAUSE ONLY THE DECORATIVE PORTION OF THE POSTER WILL BE JUDGED.
